### Windows Mobile Models

### Device Requirements

Operating System	Must run Windows Mobile 5.0 or higher
Memory	128MB minimum

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Processor	400MHz minimum
Display	Touch screen with a minimum screen size of 240x320 or greater recommended.
Keyboard	Built-in or wireless (Bluetooth) keyboard

You may also take advantage of the Windows Mobile Emulator to run HomecareNet Mobile on devices such as laptops or tablets that use the Windows XP, 2000, or 2003 operating system. This configuration allows for DUR screening to take place by a field clinician without being connected back to the home office. Please contact Healthcare Automation for laptop or tablet requirements if you plan to use this solution.

### Server Requirements

The HomecareNet Mobile database is deployed using the same database server as the HomecareNet database so extra hardware is not required for this purpose.

### Workstation Requirements for Viewer

“Viewers” are functional capabilities built into the HomecareNet software that facilitate office-based review of visit notes, encounters and documentation. Any licensed HomecareNet user authorized by security can access the Viewer, so dedicated computers are not necessary for Viewers.

### HomecareNet Mobile Host Requirements

HomecareNet Mobile requires a dedicated server PC to allow devices to connect remotely. An unlimited number of Sync Hosts accompany the HomecareNet Mobile licensing. One Host box support 10 concurrent syncs from mobile devices; plan to have one Host box for every 30-50 HomecareNet Mobile device users.
